



2012-2013 Application Information

About Our School

Los Gatos-Saratoga Observation Nursery School is a parent-child program with a focus on nature and outdoor adventures, play, and healthy foods. Our school in the woods is where parents are the students and children come to play. We offer a unique school experience that integrates an outdoor program in a natural setting with a more traditional indoor program in a charming old schoolhouse. The school has been a place of learning for teachers, parents, and children since 1956.

Children attend 1-3 days per week, depending on age. Parents attend one class per week, recording observations of their child, while the children grow and explore with their teachers and peers. Through observation and monthly parent education meetings, parents acquire an understanding of their child's development and personality. Tuition assistance is available for those in need.

Parent Participation Requirements

1. Attend one entire class session per week (per child). If you are enrolled in a two-day program, you are required to care for one other child during class, one day per week. If you are enrolled in a three-day program, you are required to care for two other children during class, one day per week.
2. Write 20 in-class observations per year (per child you have enrolled).
3. Participate in 12 evening meetings per year (per family). (8 meetings per year per family for the Saturday Afternoon class.)
4. Work 4 hours per year at the scheduled maintenance day (per family).
5. Participate in fundraising by serving on an Auction committee and contributing goods or services (per family).

Family Partnerships (Does not apply to the 2's classes and the Saturday Afternoon class)
Family Partnerships allow you to come to school just one day a week with your child, while you care for one or two other children at school. Family Partnerships provide opportunities for your child to form a trusting relationship with others. Family Partnerships are an important and enriching part of our curriculum. Family Partnership recommendations will be made in August and finalized before or by the first evening circle meeting. Family Partnerships are encouraged to meet before school begins to allow the children and parents to get to know each other and to discuss expectations. This can be very helpful in establishing a successful partnership.

School Policies

Children enrolled in classes that meet more than 1 day per week are required to attend their class regularly. Failure to do so may be cause for dismissal. Twins are recognized as two individual enrollments. Parents of twins are required to attend one class per week per child and complete 10 observations per child per semester. Children attending a 5-day pre-K or Kindergarten class are not eligible for the weekday program. However, they may enroll in the Saturday Afternoon class. Siblings 6 months and younger may attend class.

How To Apply

Please be thorough when filling out the attached application form. Indicate ALL classes that you are willing to attend and that are age-appropriate for your child by number ranking your choices (i.e., the number "1" will identify your first choice, the number "2" your second choice, and so on). Since placement in your first choice class is not guaranteed, it is strongly recommended that you select at least a second choice class. ***Please use a separate application form for each child you wish to enroll.*** Return your completed application form with your non-refundable application fee of \$60.00 (\$20.00 for each additional child) to the address listed at the bottom of the application form. Please make your check payable to "LGSONS."

All applicants will receive a written response to their application in March. Those qualified applicants not placed in a class will automatically be placed on a waiting list and notified if a spot becomes available.

Priority Registration

The priority registration period to submit applications for the 2012-2013 school year is **January 22 - February 6, 2012.** Applications **MUST** be postmarked by **February 6, 2012** to be eligible for priority registration. Applications requiring a receipt signature will not be accepted.

Families currently enrolled in the regular program, which includes all classes except the Saturday Afternoon class, wishing to re-enroll for the following year **MUST postmark their application by February 6, 2012** in order to be guaranteed a spot in the school for the following year. As long as the application is postmarked by February 6, 2012, the particular postmark date itself will not impact how the application is processed (i.e., an application postmarked 1/25/12 will not have priority over an application postmarked 2/6/12. All applications postmarked **AFTER** February 6, 2012 will be processed on a first come, first serve basis and will not be eligible to participate in the lottery for a particular class.

Currently enrolled families must be up-to-date on all obligations before submitting an application. These obligations include fundraising, maintenance, tuition, late fees, meetings, and observation requirements that were due on or before February 6th of the current school year. Children currently enrolled in the regular program will be guaranteed a spot in the school the following year if the following criteria are met:

- Application is postmarked by February 6, 2012.
- The family is up-to-date on all obligations at the end of the current school year.

How Classes are Filled

First priority is given to families who are currently enrolled in the regular program who wish to re-enroll in the regular program the following year. Current families are not guaranteed a position in their first choice class but will be placed in classes based upon space availability, teacher recommendation, and their assigned lottery number. The number of children, age, developmental level, and class balance are all considered when building a class. Children currently enrolled in the 3/4's class have priority over those currently enrolled in the 3's class for enrollment in the 4/5's class. The remaining spots in a particular class will then be filled with current Saturday Afternoon class families, then alumni families, and then with families who are new to the school. Families enrolled in the Saturday Afternoon class have priority to re-enroll in the Saturday Afternoon class the following year.

The school's policy does not allow repeating of a class in the regular program by a particular child. However, a family may petition the Board to request that a child repeat a class. The petition review and potential exception will be based on teacher recommendation, space availability, and Board approval. Families who wish for their child to attend the program for a fourth year must petition the Board. The petition review and potential exception will be based on teacher recommendation, space availability, and Board approval.

Children must be two years old and cannot be three by September 1 to be eligible for the 2's class. Children must be three years old and cannot be four by September 1 to be eligible for the 3's class. Children must be three years old and cannot be five by September 1 to be eligible for the 3/4's class. Children must be four years old by September 1 and cannot turn six before June 1 to be eligible for the 4/5's class. A family may petition the Board to admit a child whose birthday does not fall within the age requirement guidelines. The petition must accompany the family's application form and be received prior to the end of the priority registration period. The Board, Director, and Head Teacher must approve the petition to waive the age requirement. If the age waiver is approved, the age requirement will be waived in subsequent classes.

Waiting Lists

When a class has more applicants than spaces, the class is filled by a lottery. If you are placed in your second choice class, you are automatically put on the waiting list for your first choice class based on your lottery number. The waiting list is used actively throughout the current school year and during the summer to fill open spots. You will be called if a spot (or your first choice class) becomes available. However, you will be committed to the class in which you are enrolled by the first circle meeting of the new school year. At that time, all waiting lists for families enrolled in the regular program will be eliminated. If a position becomes available after the first circle meeting, it will be filled by the remaining applicants on the waiting list. Applicants who are not enrolled in the school will remain on the waiting list until the next application period. The school's waiting list does not roll over from year to year.
